The new Lions Year has started and the MD22 100th Anniversary is one of the first visitations that our new 105th International **President Brian Sheehan** and Lion Lori will be attending.



Brian E. Sheehan, from Bird Island, Minnesota, USA, was elected to serve as international president of Lions Clubs International at the association's 104th International Convention, June 22 through June 28, 2022.

As part of a four-generation Lions family, International President Brian Sheehan has always had big ideas about service. His life and career have been defined by family, small-town connections and kindness, and a passion for innovation and teamwork as the keys to creating ambitious solutions to the challenges we face. President Sheehan's programs and initiatives will focus on four key priorities for Lions International that are critical to our mission of service.

1. Sharing the joy of being a Lion
2. Supporting our global foundation, LCIF
3. Thinking bigger when we serve
4. Advocating for local and global causes

President Sheehan is the founder and CEO of Rural Computer Consultants, a software development company. A member of the Bird Island Lions Club since 1991, he has held many offices within the association, including council chairperson, long range planning chairperson, membership chairperson, retention chairperson, women's initiative chairperson, MD convention chairperson, GMT Liaison and GLT area leader. He has also served as the chairperson of the Headquarter Operation & Finance Committee, Lions University coordinator, DGE group leader, and board

appointee to several committees including Constitutions and Bylaws, LCIF Executive, LCI Executive, USA/Canada Lions Leadership Forum and the Centennial Action committees. He has been a presenter at numerous Lions events, including many of the Global Forums. In recognition of his service to the association, he has received numerous awards including Club Lion of the Year; the District 5M 4 Diabetes Awareness Award; the MD 5M Web Site Appreciation Award; the MD 5M Al Jensen Leadership Award; the Founders Membership Growth Award; numerous International President's Certificates of Appreciation; International President's Leadership Award; multiple International President's Awards; and the Ambassador of Good Will Award, the highest honor the association bestows upon its members. He is also a Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow and Second Century Ambassador.

In addition to his Lions activities, President Sheehan is active in numerous professional and community organizations. He has served as president of Bird Island Civic and Commerce, director of the Learning Funhouse and as a member of various school committees. He also received the 2011 U.S. SBA Minnesota Small Businessperson of the Year Award.

President Sheehan and his wife, Lori, also a Lion and Progressive Melvin Jones Fellow, have two sons and two daughters. And in their spare time, they have enjoyed raising many types of exotic animals.

Set-up	Assist w/setting up bocce courts, signage, tables & chairs	10
Registration	Greet Lions, Leos & Special Olympics athletes as they arrive & assign them to teams. NOTE: the set-up personnel can transition to registration	6
Court Officials	We will provide an orientation/training about officiating bocce matches as these individuals will officiate all matches continuously throughout the day at their assigned court. NOTE: the set-up registration personnel can transition to this role.	24
Officials Assistant	We will provide an orientation/training about officiating bocce matches as these individuals will partner with an official on a court to officiate continuously throughout the day.	24

Score Keepers	Work on court with official to keep score during the bocce matches. If we don't have enough volunteers to provide score keepers for each court the official and officials' assistants can keep score.	24
Awards	Assist with set up, staging and presentation of awards	10
Results	Enter and post results	3
Information	Sit at information stations to distribute match information, as well as answer questions about the venue (lunch & awards location)	1
Announcer	Provides instructions on starting & completing matches coordinating with timekeeper. Provide any other announcements as deemed necessary	1
Escorts	Upon arrival, escort or direct Teams to their assigned courts. Upon completing all matches, direct team to awards area.	5
Water Assistants	Assist with water distribution throughout venue.	2
